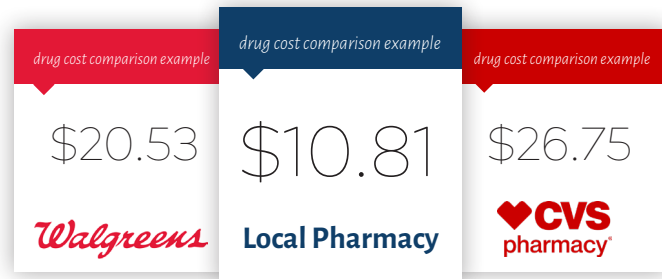


Prescription Drug Resources

COMPARE AND SAVE PRESCRIPTION DRUG COSTS

Did you know that cost of a medication can vary by pharmacy?

Try using GoodRx to compare pharmacy costs and check for retail coupons. If the GoodRx coupon price is lower than the insurance price, you can purchase a medication using the GoodRx coupon to reduce your cost, and submit your receipt to memberservices@epiphanyrx.com to get credit toward the out-of-pocket on your MPC insurance policy.
