

How to Use the 2026 Medicare Plan Finder

Tip: Before you begin, make a list of your medications including strength and daily dose or have your pill bottles handy.

1. Go to www.medicare.gov
2. Under **It's Open Enrollment – now to Dec 7** (upper left corner), **click** [Find Plans](#).
3. On the right side of the next page, enter your **Zip Code**, select your **County** if prompted, **click** [Continue](#).
4. Under **Type of Plan**, select “Medicare drug plan (Part D)”, **click** [Find Plans](#).
5. Under **Help with your costs**, select “I don’t get help from any of these programs” **click** [Continue](#).
6. Under “Do you want to see your drug costs when you compare plans?” **click** [Yes](#), then **click** [Next](#).
7. Enter your first drug. As you type the name, a list of drugs that match what you’re typing will appear. Select the drug from the list, then **click** [Add Drug](#).
8. Select appropriate **Dosage**, **Quantity**, and **Frequency**, then **click** [Add to My Drug List](#).
9. If you have more drugs to add, **click** [Add Another Drug](#) and repeat until all your drugs are listed. Then **click** [Done Adding Drugs](#).
10. Enter your address or ZIP code and optionally, the name of your preferred pharmacy, then **click** [Find Pharmacies](#). **Click** [Add Pharmacy](#) checkbox to the right of your preferred pharmacy(ies), then **click** [Continue to View Plans](#) on the bottom blue bar.
11. Make sure SORT PLANS BY is set to “Lowest drug + premium cost”; the first plan listed on the next page will be the plan with the lowest overall cost based on the yearly premium and drug cost estimate.
12. **Click** on [Plan Details](#) for specific cost information or **click** [Enroll](#) to enroll in this plan.
