Opportunity to save on drug costs

If you find that a prescription costs less using a GoodRx coupon than running it through insurance, you can buy the drug with the GoodRx coupon and then email your receipt to membershipservices@epiphanyrx.com to get credit toward the out-of-pocket on your Anthem medical insurance policy.

Using the GoodRx mobile app (available on the App Store and Google Play), you can find the lowest local prices for your prescriptions at more than 70,000 U.S. pharmacies. GoodRx coupons can save you up to 80% on your prescriptions at no cost to you. It's easy; just show the GoodRx app to your pharmacist when picking up your prescription. Track prices and get notified with the latest saving alerts for your prescriptions.

Applications, changes due December 9

On January 1, employees who previously waived coverage can enroll in the group plan by completing an **Anthem Enrollment Application** (available from the primary contact at your group) and emailing or faxing it to ISMA Insurance Agency for processing.

Insured employees who previously waived coverage for dependents can add them by completing an **Anthem Enrollment Application** (available from the primary contact at your group) and emailing or faxing it to ISMA Insurance Agency for processing. All requests for January 1 changes should be submitted by December 9 to allow time for processing.

Anthem Summaries of Benefits available online

In compliance with the Affordable Care Act (ACA), a Summary of Benefits and Coverage (SBC) for each MPC 2023 Anthem health insurance plan is available online at www.indianampc.org.

The SBC provides standardized and easy-to-understand information about health plan benefits and coverage. Paper copies are available free of charge upon request.

New Anthem ID cards with Rx information

Anthem plans to issue new ID cards to all MPC subscribers between late December and mid-January. New cards will include RxBIN, RxPCN, and RxGRP numbers so you can present your Anthem ID card at your pharmacy instead of having to use your separate EpiphanyRx ID card. EpiphanyRx's Pharmacy Help Line will be printed on the reverse side of the new Anthem ID cards.
